## CODE OF ETHICS

August 2007

The Code of Ethics must be signed and followed by all sober living management staff. This statement commits the signer to adhere to this code of ethics and to maintain a vital concern for the lives and well being of all persons. In signing this Code of Ethics, I agree to:

1. Be dedicated to recognizing the dignity and worth of all human beings.
2. Maintain an alcohol and illicit drug free environment.
3. Maintain quality housing that is consistent with the quality of the neighborhood. Demonstrate activities that benefit the immediate neighbors.
4. If an alcoholic or addict, to remain abstinent. If not an alcoholic or addict, to remain alcohol free during performance hours. If an operator, to ensure that managers and staff are clean and sober at least 9 months and remain abstinent, if an individual is an alcoholic or addict.
5. Submit to random drug testing at the request of the Sober Living Coalition.
6. Exercise no physical violence, nor threaten violence, in the home. I will not tolerate either on the premises..
7. If I am a manager or staff, to never become romantically or sexually involved with home lodgers or anyone the sober living home is assisting.
8. If I am a manager or staff, to never become involved with lodgers' financial affairs. This covers borrowing or lending money, buying or selling property or other financial transactions.
9. Respect the privacy and personal rights of all lodgers.
10. Assure that no weapons are allowed on sober living premises

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### PERSONAL STATEMENT

I commit myself to strive at all times to maintain the highest standards in all services I provide. In the event that I violate any of the above ethics, I understand that my membership in the San Diego Sober Living Coalition will be terminated.
